

Acute Care Rotation Program (ACRP)

BENEFITS

- Provides RNs with a solid first year of nursing experience
- Allows the opportunity to work in a wide variety of units to gain different experience
- Extensive orientation period
- No previous acute care experience needed

- Work 36 hours/week
- Vacations scheduled with program manager (not granted during orientation)
- Schedule includes every other weekend and half of nationally recognized holidays
- Eligible to apply for a regular position during any rotation

REQUIREMENTS

- BSN (waived for current team members)
- RN licensure in the state of Florida



Rotation/assignment to a specific unit and/or shift may be requested, but not guaranteed. Units and/or shifts are assigned based on program restrictions, available preceptor resources, specific unit needs and participant preferences.



VIZIENT/AACN NURSE RESIDENCY PROGRAM

Tampa General Nurse Residency Program (NRP) utilizes the curriculum and structures of the national Vizient/AACN Nurse Residency Program[™], the nation's top nurse residency curriculum. Participation in the nurse residency is required of all employed graduate nurses or RN with less than 1 year experience in an acute care hospital. This one year program is designed to empower the new nurse with knowledge of resources, processes, and confidence to assume the role of bedside patient care leader, be engaged in improving patient quality and outcomes, and advance from novice to advanced beginner as a professional nurse.



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ROTATION STRUCTURE

Session 1 (12 weeks) • first unit

Week 1: New team member orientation Week 2-12: Train in first unit and attend the Acute Care Transition Program. Train 8-9 weeks, work as a team member for 3-4 weeks.

Session 2 (8 weeks) • new unit

Week 13-20: Train on a different unit for 2 weeks. Work as a team member for 6 weeks.

Session 3 (8 weeks) • new unit

Week 21-28: Train on a different unit for one week. Work as a team member for seven weeks on the same unit.

Session 4-6 (8 weeks) • new unit

Week 29-52 or completion: Train on a different unit for one shift (12 hours). Work as a team member for the remaining time on the unit.
